One of the hallmarks of a Rivendell education is that it is a shared experience: parents and students learning, working, and growing together. Our Parent Involvement requirement is substantial, but one that communicates to our students the value our parents place on education at Rivendell.

This list is intended to provide an overview of the volunteer jobs at Rivendell School, as well as to provide information on whom to contact to get involved. While extensive, it is by no means all-inclusive. Many of the volunteer positions are sibling-friendly, meaning that younger-than-school-aged siblings can be present while the parent is volunteering in that capacity. Volunteer positions where siblings may not be present are indicated No Siblings (no sibs). If the job can be performed in the school after school hours or during the day outside of school, it will be indicated as Outside-of-School (OS).

CORE HOURS

Core Hours are volunteer hours that are essential for the school to function without hiring additional staff. They support our teachers and administrative staff tremendously. These are the first priorities to address when looking for volunteer opportunities. All parents are urged to sign up for at least **one hour per week** of core duty activities. Descriptions of the responsibilities of each of the core duty volunteer jobs can be found on the Rivendell School website.

 - o 6th Grade New York City trip (16 hrs)
 - o 3rd Form camping trip (8 hrs)

- Assist with planning, coordination, or clean-up (OS)
 - o Fall Festival
 - Shakespeare Festival
 - o 4th Form 6th grade Swing Dance (no sibs)
 - Pool party (no sibs)

Note that younger siblings should not accompany the parent while chaperoning trips or certain events.
